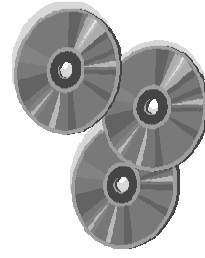

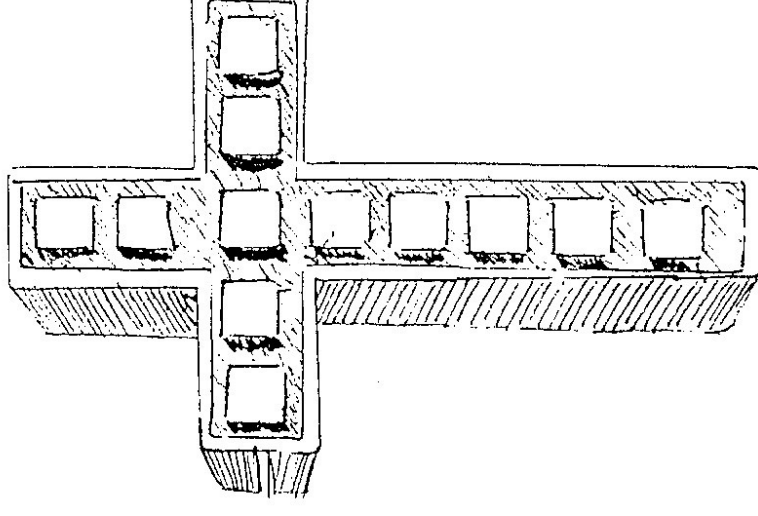

**LOWER LEVEL MOVE OUT** - We need a second truck and 4 or 5 volunteers for the final clearing. Please pray about helping and contact the church office.

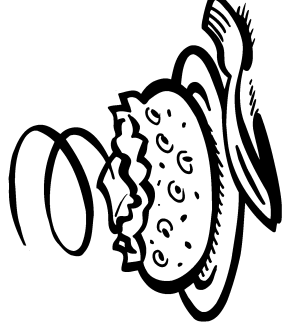
